BA Course Outcomes

BA (History)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The program orients students with traditional historical knowledge along with advanced contemporary skills like the role of remote sensing, Carbon dating and GIS in the field of history and archaeology.• Promote research, innovation and design (Map and Atlas) development favouring all the disciplines in History.

From media to activism, sociology scope in India is as expansive as a spectrum, holding diverse opportunities for candidates to learn their potential in a suitable field and follow the same. ● It also teaches students the method to investigate different structures, such as groups of people, institutions, and society as an entity.
BA (Political Science)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Develops understanding and evaluation of the functions of politics, the government, and society among students. ● Political Science is one of the optional subjects for the UPSC exam, aspiring bureaucrats who already have an educational background in political science grab the PSIR concepts quicker than the rest.

BA (Home Science)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Designed to enhance the capacity of students to understand universal and domain-specific values in Home Science. ● Develop the ability to address the complexities and interface among of self, societal and national priorities. ● Inculcate both generic and subject-specific skills to succeed in the employment market and standards of life ● Promote research, innovation and design (product) development favouring all the disciplines in Home Science. ● May have capabilities to start earning by enhancing their skills in the field of Nutrition and Textiles. ● Enhance abilities involved in acting as proactive agents of change in promoting the discipline of Family and Community Sciences. ● After this degree programme students can be benefitted by getting jobs in various fields like government sector, working with NGOs, jobs as an extension worker, Education etc. and also they can feel the sense of entrepreneurship as well.

B.Ed, B.El.Ed & M.Ed Course Outcomes

B.Ed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● B.Ed. graduates with knowledge of particular subjects, such as math, science, English, social studies, or languages, may be able to find employment as subject specialists. ● Bachelor of Education graduates can help with curriculum development and instructional design. They may collaborate with educational publishers, educational technology companies, or government agencies to create curriculum materials, textbooks, e-learning modules, and educational resources. ● B.Ed. graduates with an entrepreneurial spirit can start their own educational businesses, such as tutoring centres, coaching institutes, or educational startups.

B.Sc (Home Science)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Provides students with opportunities to work in teaching, sales, technical, and services sectors in the private sector. Students can also work in the food industry, such as in food preservation, cooking, and food analysis. ● It also caters to the present-day needs of multidisciplinary education providing solutions in societal and environmental contexts and demonstrating the knowledge and need for sustainable development.

MA English	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Hones the writing skills of students and they learn the conventions of academic writing. ● Instils a critical perspective with which students approach the disciplines. ● Introduces different literary periods and trends of each of these periods. ● Postgraduates with an MA in English often find rewarding career opportunities as content writers in various sectors such as publishing houses, media organizations, advertising agencies, and digital marketing firms. ● Pursuing a Master of Arts (MA) in English equips students with a deep understanding of literature, critical thinking skills, and analytical abilities, which are highly beneficial for competitive exams such as the National Eligibility Test (NET) for lecturership or research fellowship.

They can create and sell your artwork through galleries, exhibitions, online platforms, or commissioned projects.

MA Hindi	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● After students complete the M.A Hindi course, they can look forward to many potential job opportunities in various fields like Teaching, Mass Media, Bank Services Research and extension services and many other Government of India offices under official language policy. ● This enables the students to appear in all competitive exams by taking Hindi subject as the main course, especially in KSET, NET, IAS, etc.
